Will Storecove support integration with the Public Invoicing Portal (PPF) as well as Chorus Pro?

- Yes, we will support integration with PPF and Chorus Pro.

When will the French test environment be available, and how can clients start testing?

- There is no test option available yet. We will publish an update as soon as this becomes available.

What are the required fields and setup mappings between my company and Storecove according to French regulations?

- That information is not yet available. We will publish an update as soon as it is.

When will Storecove be PA certified by the French authorities?

- Storecove's PA application has been officially approved. We will be fully registered as a PA after completing interoperability testing by early March.



What is a PA?

- PA stands for Plateforme Agréée. PA providers are authorized to transmit invoice and tax information to the French tax authority on behalf of businesses.

Which invoice formats are accepted in France?

- France accepts Factur-X (hybrid PDF/XML), UBL, and CII formats.

What types of transactions are covered by the French e-invoicing mandate?

- The mandate applies to all domestic B2B transactions between VAT-registered companies in France. Medium and large companies must comply by 1 September 2026, while all other companies must comply by 1 September 2027.

Do companies need to register directly with the French tax authorities?

- No, companies working with Storecove do not need to register directly. Storecove, as a PA, will handle the required connections and reporting to the French authorities on your behalf.

Do international companies with operations in France also need to comply?

- Yes. Any company that is VAT-registered in France and issues or receives invoices for domestic B2B transactions must comply with the mandate, regardless of where their headquarters are located.
